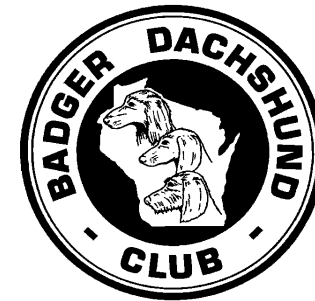

- 1) All fees for **conformation and obedience**: Include the 50¢ AKC Recording Fee and the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes. Fees for **rally** include the \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee on each entry of a dog in Rally and a \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog. Note: There is no recording fee or event service fee for junior showmanship, sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes or special attractions.
- 2) Please note that rally is a separate event from the specialty (conformation & obedience); therefore, you must pay the first entry fee (not the additional entry fee) if you also are entering in conformation or obedience.

A Qualifying score is required for all prizes and ribbons offered in the regular classes.

Bitches in Season (Obedience & Rally)

Obedience & Rally Transfers (will be allowed for these trials)

Bitches in Season: If a bitch entered in the obedience or rally classes comes in season after the Trial's closing date, entry will be fully refunded, less a processing fee of \$6.00.

Transfers (formerly called move-ups): After a dog earns a title, it may be transferred to another class in a future trial, even though the closing date for the trial has passed. A transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records the handler and dog are eligible and the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit. Movement between an "A" and "B" class at the same level is not considered a transfer – refer to Chapter 1, Section 16b.

SWEEPSTAKES ~ DACHSHUNDS ONLY

Only Offered on Sunday, March 18

(Entry Fee for Puppy Sweepstakes is \$16.00)

(Enter eligible Dachshunds in the sweepstakes on the same entry form as their entry in the regular classes. Indicate SWEEPSTAKES in the space for "Additional Classes" and state which Sweepstakes Class.)

The Sweepstakes competition will be for Dogs and Bitches which are 6 months and under 18 months of age on the date of the sweepstakes competition. **Must also be entered in a regular conformation class.** Classes **(all coats combined)** will be divided by age and sex as follows:

(Entry Fee for 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy is \$16.00)

For dogs that are four months of age and over, but under six months on the day of the event.

- AKC registration # or an AKC litter # is required.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies).
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.

AKC Owner-Handled Series – Offered on Saturday & Sunday, March 17-18

The AKC Owner/Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog.*

- ❖ Professional handlers, household members & current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting as a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.
- ❖ Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner/Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form.
- ❖ The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show.
- ❖ Dogs declared eligible will be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the steward's book and in the show catalog.
- ❖ Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner-handler eligible for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series through the breed level competition for the regular show. This includes the class competition & subsequent competition in the variety ring. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition.
- ❖ The Owner/Handled Best of Variety will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Variety competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and the undefeated winners of the non-regular classes. *This excludes all dogs defeated during class & winners competition for the regular show.*

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES

Only Offered on Saturday, March 17 (Specialty #1 – AM)

Entry Fee for Junior Showmanship is \$11.00 if not entered in any other class
FREE as an additional entry

NOVICE CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls, who at the time entries close, have not won three first places, with competition present, in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

OPEN CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls who have won three first place awards in a Novice class in a licensed or member show, with competition present. The winner of a Novice Class shall automatically become eligible, upon notice to the Open Class ring steward, to enter and compete in the Open Class at the same show provided the win is the 3rd first place award with competition and further providing there are one or more junior handlers competing in the Open Class.

MASTER CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 – October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES (Cont.)

The Novice and Open Classes will be divided into **Junior, Intermediate and Senior** divisions.

The **Junior** class is for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show.

The **Intermediate** class shall be for the boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years on the day of the show.

The **Senior** class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

The **Master** class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 – October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

BEST JUNIOR HANDLER: The junior handler placed first in each of the regular Junior Showmanship Classes, if undefeated in any other Junior Showmanship Class at this show, shall automatically be eligible to compete for this prize.

AKC New Exhibitor Briefing

The New Exhibitor Briefing will help new exhibitors understand the dog show and feel more comfortable with the sport. The briefing will explain the duties of the superintendent or show secretary, the AKC Executive Field Staff, the event committee, the ring steward, ring location, exercise areas, and assist with grooming space. We will explain dog show classes, point computation, and verification of placements (judge's book tear sheets). All exhibitors, new and seasoned, are welcome to participate. There is no cost for this briefing; however, we ask that you sign up with the show secretary.

The briefing will be held near the conformation ring, beginning one hour before conformation judging on Saturday, March 17.

SHOW REGULATIONS

- **Mats must be used under metal crates. Also grooming tables and/or chairs if they do not have rubber feet.**
- All **heavy grooming, including hair dryers**, and use of grooming products (chalk, sprays, etc.) must be used in the south (small) room only.
Light grooming (limited clipping, brushing, combing) may be done in the north (large) room.
- **SHOW SITE will be available to exhibitors at approximately 4:00 PM CDT on Friday, March 16, 2018**
- **DOGS MAY ARRIVE** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. (The building will be open at 7:30 a.m. Saturday & Sunday) Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
- Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.
- There will be no refund for duplicate entries.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures.
- **POST-DATED CHECKS AND RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. The BDC will add a collection fee of \$35 to the amount of each returned check.
- If acknowledgement of entry is not received by exhibitor within a reasonable period of time, please notify the show secretary.
- Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing (e-mail acceptable) prior to the closing of entries.
- If a bitch entered in the obedience or rally classes comes in season after the Trial's closing date, the entry will be fully refunded, less a processing fee of \$6.00.
- The show giving Club, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- **CLASS CASH PRIZES** will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before. The Show Secretary and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.
- **NO DOG UNDER 4 MONTHS OF AGE ARE PERMITTED IN THE BUILDING. ONLY DOGS THAT ARE AKC ELIGIBLE ARE ALLOWED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.**
- Parents are responsible for supervising their children.
- Owners and Handlers are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs and children.
- No Smoking in the building.
- Dogs may **NOT** be left in the grooming room overnight.
- **THE BDC DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THESE EVENTS.**
- Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the grounds clean. Please pick up after your dogs.
- **Anyone witnessed not picking up after his/her dog will be excused from the specialty weekend with no monies refunded.**
- **SHOW & HOTEL REGULATIONS WILL BE AGGRESSIVELY ENFORCED. ANY VIOLATION MAY RESULT IN THE EXHIBITOR'S IMMEDIATE EVICTION FROM THE HOTEL AND SPECIALTY WITH NO REFUNDS. EXHIBITOR MAY BE SUBJECT TO FURTHER DISCIPLINE, INCLUDING AKC MISCONDUCT.**

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
